Welsh School of Anaesthesia : Available units of training (March 2005) – Individual Hospitals

**** Intensive care medicine (ICM) training:** Almost all SpR rotations will include exposure to ICM training in more than one centre. The Welsh School of Anaesthesia feels that this is appropriate and will provide complementary experience in this central area of clinical practice. The ICM unit of training workplace assessment should usually be finally signed off when all of the ICM attachments have been completed. **NB** trainees planning a career in ICM should seek the advice of their local educational supervisor for ICM or the Regional Advisor for ICM (Dr Chris Thorpe, Bangor) or their tutor at the earliest opportunity.

Bangor

- ◆ Paediatric 1mth module at Alder hey (Liverpool) may be available for SpR 1-2 and 3-4-5 trainees. Advanced posts may also be available for SpR 3-4-5 trainees. Enquire with local department and Welsh School well in advance.
- ◆ Some daycase and dental cases available, but main Maxillo-facial unit in Rhyl
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 higher training may be available for vascular surgery
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for Pain management may become available

Cardiff

- ◆ SpR 1-2 key units of training are prioritised. Wherever possible, general units should be signed off before rotating to Cardiff
- ◆ Vascular experience may be limited
- ◆ There are SpR 3-4-5 higher and advanced Research posts

Carmarthen

- ◆ Significant experience available in pain management. SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for Pain management may become available.
- ◆ Tailored programmes can be set up for individual trainees

Llanelli

- ◆ Units being developed (possibly in combination with Carmarthen eg pain). Good experience in ITU, vascular and general surgery.

Merthyr

- ◆ Some experience in paediatrics.
- ◆ ACLS and ATLS training centre

Newport

- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for obstetrics may become available
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for emergency anaesthesia and outreach may become available

Royal Glamorgan

- ◆ ITU training unit being developed
- ◆ Training in pain available, may need extra experience elsewhere (SpR1-2 and 3-4-5)
- ◆ Some experience available for diagnostics and X-Ray
- ◆ Tailored programmes can be set up for SpR3-4-5s, including good managerial experience

Rhyl

- ◆ Paediatric 1mth module at Alder hey (Liverpool) may be available for SpR 1-2 and 3-4-5 trainees. Advanced posts may also be available for SpR 3-4-5 trainees. Enquire with local department and Welsh School well in advance
- ◆ Some ITU training but not recognised for ICBICM training (Inter-Collegiate Board in Intensive Care Medicine)
- ◆ Some SpR 3-4-5 training in obstetrics, pain, vascular, ENT and orthopaedics
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for Pain management may become available

Swansea

- ◆ SpR 1-2 Paediatric training unit being developed
- ◆ Acute pain experience available
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training available for vascular surgery. Enquire with local department well in advance
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for obstetrics may become available

Wrexham

- ◆ Paediatric 1mth module at Alder hey (Liverpool) may be available for SpR 1-2 and 3-4-5 trainees. Advanced posts may also be available for SpR 3-4-5 trainees. Enquire with local department and Welsh School well in advance.
- ◆ SpR 3-4-5 advanced training post for Pain management may become available
